Dancing, walking and learning new languages. I also love going home to visit my family and playing with my pet cat, Claude!

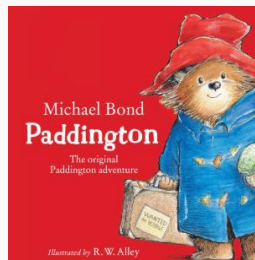
Drink: I love a nice cup of tea!

Dessert: Cheesecake

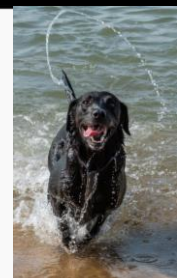
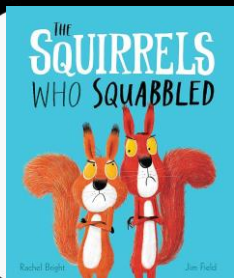
Hobbies/Interests: Swimming, playing the cello, reading and walking my dog Bella.

Dessert: vanilla ice-cream with nuts and berries



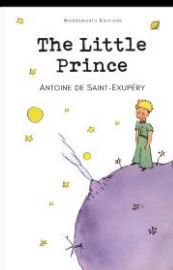
Hobbies/Interests: aikido, long walks with my dog, nature, science
