Dessert: Anything with chocolate!

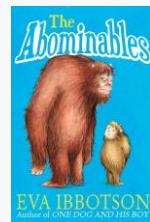
Hobbies/Interests: I enjoy visiting new places and walking/ running with my dog, spending time with my children and doing DIY.

Dessert: vanilla ice-cream with nuts and berries



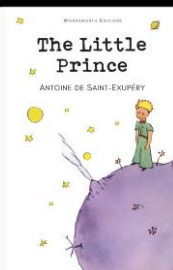
Hobbies/Interests: aikido, long walks with my dog, nature, science
