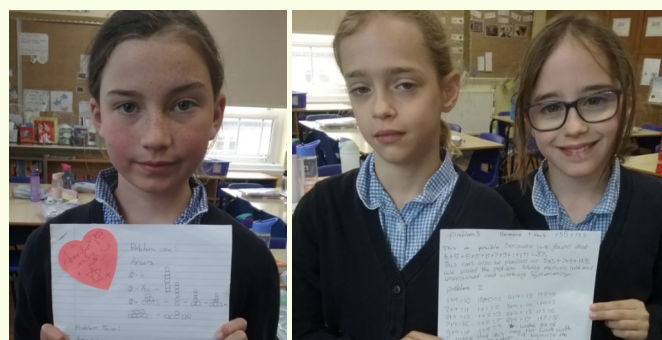

Y4 MTC Tests

We are incredibly proud of our Y4 children who have completed the MTC Tests. Our Multiplication Tables Check follows the exact specification as laid out in the KS2 National Curriculum Assessments published by the Standards & Testing Agency. All the children were amazing, we are very proud of them.

Phonic Screening

In Y1, the children take a Phonics Screening Check (PSC) to assess their phonics and decoding skills. The check involves reading 40 words, both real and nonsense, to see if they can decode them using their phonics knowledge. Our Y1 children were brilliant this week. They approached the test like troopers. Well done Y1; we are very proud!

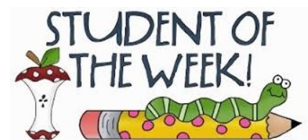
