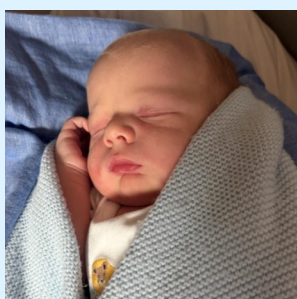

NEAR MISS

We need to address an important safety concern.

In recent weeks, we have seen an increase in cars stopping directly outside the astro gates on Jessop Avenue during both drop-off and pick-up times. This behaviour is creating the same risks we previously faced on St James' Square.

This week, a four-year-old child on their bike experienced a near miss. We are extremely grateful that no one was hurt, but this highlights how serious the situation has become.

To protect every child, we have adjusted our start- and end-of-day procedures. However, these measures can only be effective if all families follow the rules designed to keep our community safe.

Jessop Avenue is not a safe or legal place to stop. The Waitrose car park is only a short walk from the astro gate, and there is no reason for any parent or carer to park or stop illegally on Jessop Avenue.

We are asking for everyone's full co-operation to ensure that no child is put at risk.
