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School Uniform Reminder

We have always been proud of our pupils' appearance throughout the school and how, when worn correctly, our school uniform gives a respectful and smart appearance.

Can we please remind you that we are still in Winter uniform until the Easter Holidays and to ask that all families are following the guidance below to ensure we are all looking our best each day.

Our school colour is navy & grey

- Skirts, Pinafores and trousers should be grey. Not black.
- Shirts should be white and clean
- Jumpers and Cardigans should be navy (not grey or black)

- Socks should be black, grey, navy or white
- Tights should be black, grey or navy
- Footwear – should be sturdy, school shoes or ankle boots (no open-toed sandals should be worn)
