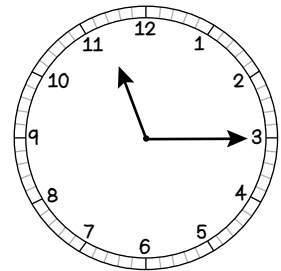
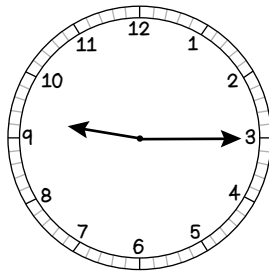
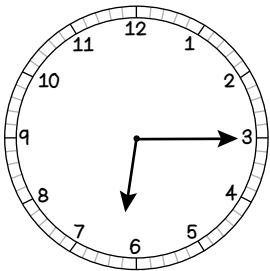
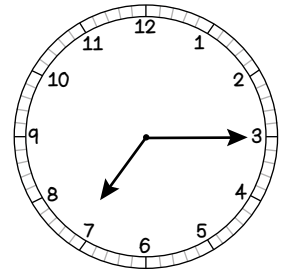
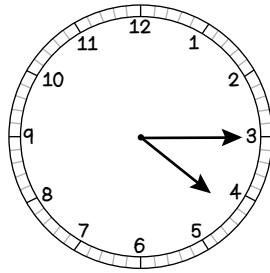
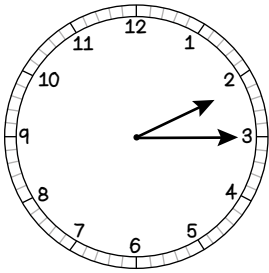
The table below indicates which activities are linked to which manageable steps.

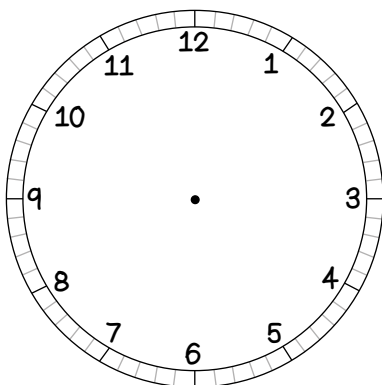

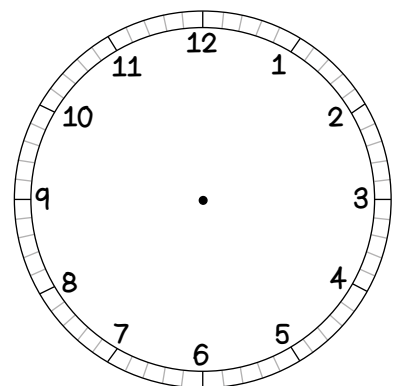


Challenge It 1

Spread the cards out face down on the table.

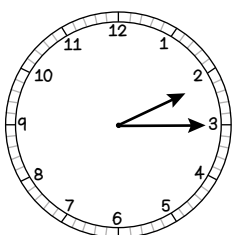
Players take turns to select two cards.

If the cards match, (time and clock), the player keeps the pair.

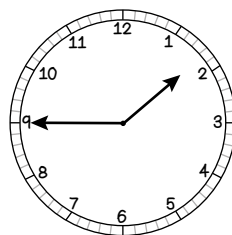
To win:

The winner is the player with the most pairs.

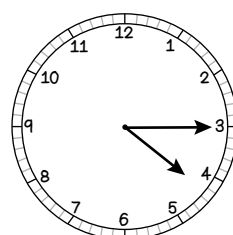

Which is the Longest?

Play It 3

You need:
Time cards

To play:
The cards are mixed up and placed face down.
Player 1 turns over one card.
Player 2 turns over another card.
The player with the card showing the longest time wins the pair of cards.

To win:
The winner is the player with the largest number of pairs of cards.

10 minutes	30 minutes	40 minutes	50 minutes
$\frac{1}{2}$ hour	$\frac{1}{4}$ hour	1 hour	2 hours
70 minutes	80 minutes	90 minutes	100 minutes
20 hours	25 hours	30 hours	1 day
