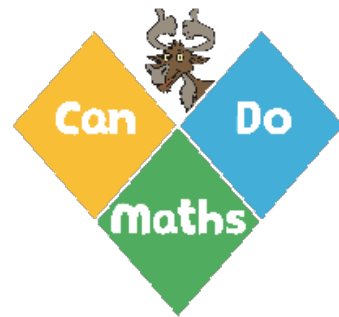




Colin and Coco's Deliberate Practice

Do It 1

Money, Money, Money Game

Play It 1

You need:

1p, 2p and 5p cards

To play:

The cards are placed face down.

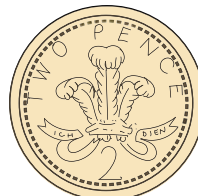
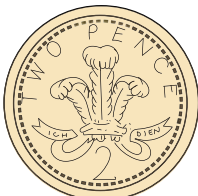
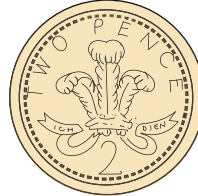
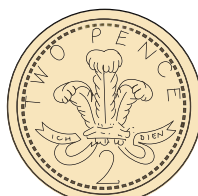
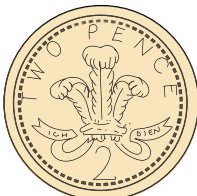
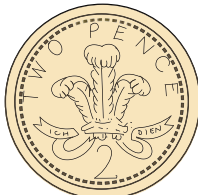
Each player picks 4 cards and works out the total.

The player with the largest total wins 1 point.

The cards are put back face down and shuffled.

To win:

The winner is the first player to score 10 points.





Do It 2

Find the total amount of money:

$$2p + 3p + 5p = \boxed{} \quad 10p + 20p + 15p = \boxed{} \quad 13p + 10p + 6p = \boxed{}$$

$$2p + 4p + 5p = \boxed{} \quad 23p + 21p + 30p = \boxed{} \quad 14p + 22p + 10p = \boxed{}$$

$$6p + 1p + 5p = \boxed{} \quad 14p + 26p + 25p = \boxed{} \quad 8p + 12p + 25p = \boxed{}$$

How Many Coins? Game

Play It 2

You need:

3 Dice 1 - 6

Pile of 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p, 20p, 50p coins

To play:

Each player takes turns to roll the two dice to create a 2-digit amount of money.

Each player then rolls the 3rd dice.

If they roll 1, 2 or 3, they now use up to 4 coins from the pile to make their 2-digit amount of money.

If they roll 4, 5 or 6, they now use 5 or more coins from the pile to make their 2-digit amount of money

If it is not possible to make the amount, the player misses their go.

A player scores one point for each amount they make.

To win:

The winner is the first player to score 10 points.

Calculate the change from £1 if you spend:

Challenge It 3

Colin buys some sweets and pays with a 50p coin.
His change is 1 silver coin and 1 bronze coin.
Investigate how much he could have spent.

Colin buys some more sweets and pays with a 50p coin.
His change is 1 silver coin and 2 bronze coins.
Investigate how much he could have spent.

Colin buys some more sweets and pays with a 50p coin.
His change is 2 silver coins and 1 bronze coin.
Investigate how much he could have spent.



All Change Game

Play It 3

You need:

Number cards Set A

Number cards Set B

To play:

The cards from each set are mixed up and placed face down.

Player 1 turns over two cards from Set A

Player 2 turns over two cards from Set B.

Players use their cards to create a 2-digit amount of money to spend.

Player 1 calculates the change from 50p.

Player 2 calculates the change from £1

The player with the largest amount of change wins 1 point.

To win:

The winner is the first player to score 10 points.

Swap roles and play again.
