The price of a child ticket on a Saturday is the same as the price of an adult ticket Monday - Friday

The price of a child ticket on a Sunday is the same as the price of a child ticket on Monday - Friday

The price of a child ticket on a Thursday is £7.50

The price of a family ticket on a Saturday is double the price on a Friday

The price of an adult ticket on a Wednesday is £12

The price of a family ticket on a Monday is £30

The price of an adult ticket on a Sunday is double the price of a child ticket on Monday - Friday

The price of an adult ticket on a Saturday is £5 more than an adult ticket on Sunday

Line Graph Game

Play It 1

You need:

Card Set A

Card Set B - The line graphs show the distance of Colin from his home at different times during the day.

To play:

Shuffle the cards and place them in two decks, face down.

Players take turns to turn over a card from set A and set B.

Using the line graph on their card, they work out the distance from home at the time shown on their other card.

The distance is their score.

To win:

The winner is the first player to score over 250 or the player with the highest score after five goes each.
