Coin Patterns

Challenge It 1

Using a bag of 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p coins, create:

- a repeating pattern of coins using two different coins
- a repeating pattern of coins using three different coins

Pick the Coin Game

Play It 1

You need:

Bag of 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p coins.

To play:

Player 1 randomly picks a coin.

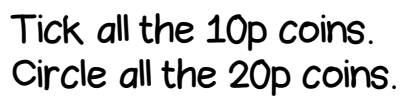
Without removing it from the bag, they try to guess the coin by feeling it.

They pull the coin out of the bag and if they are correct, they keep the coin.

Player 2 has a turn.

To win:

The winner is the player with the most coins after 5 goes.



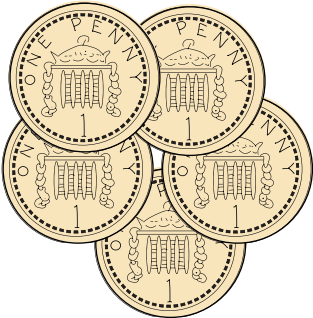

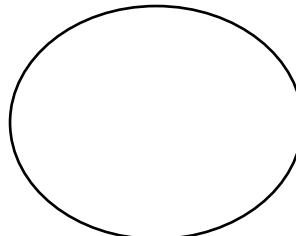
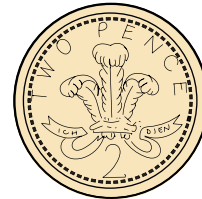
