Find three things that are not cuboids. How do you know they are not cuboids?



3-D shapes in a Bag

Play It 1

You need:

A range of 3-D shapes in a bag

To play: (This is a collaborative activity.)

Challenge your partner to put their hand into the bag and, without looking, pick out a shape you either name or describe.

You could challenge them to pick out a shape that is not a named shape.

For example:

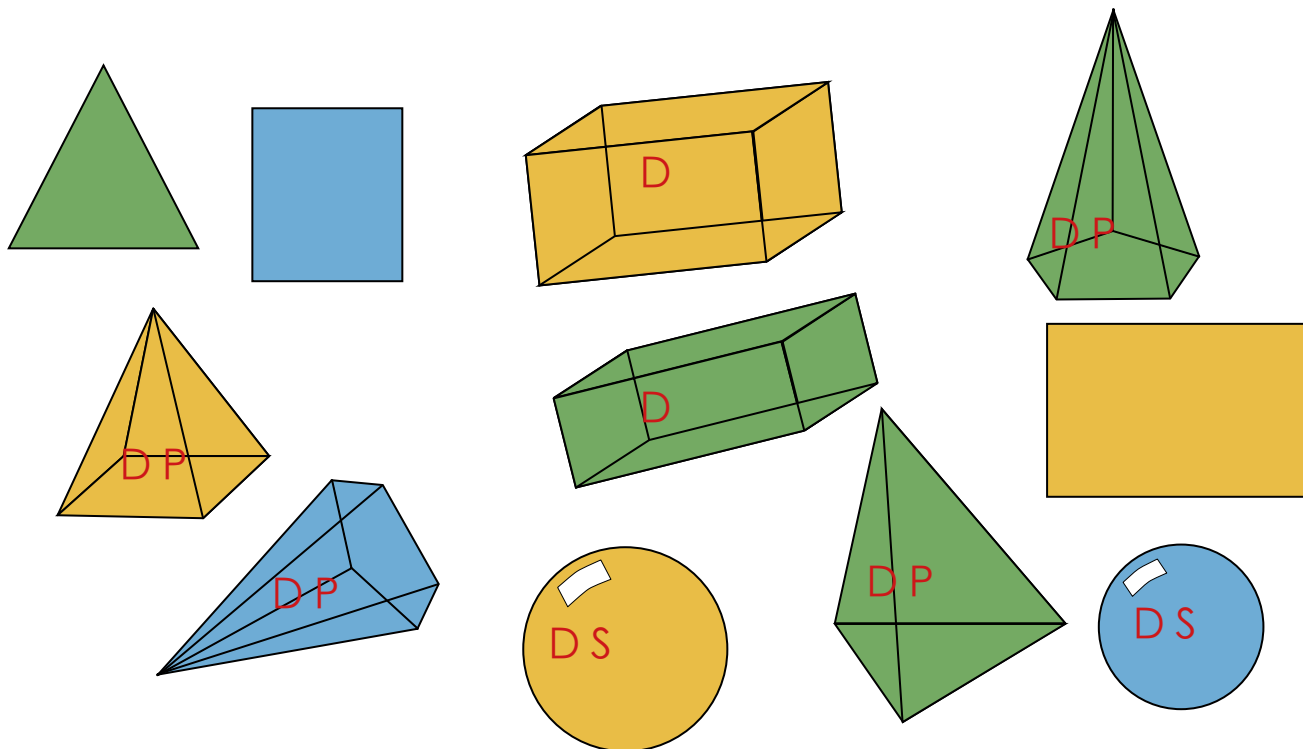
Player 1: Find a shape that is not a cuboid.

Player 2: Find a shape that is a cube.



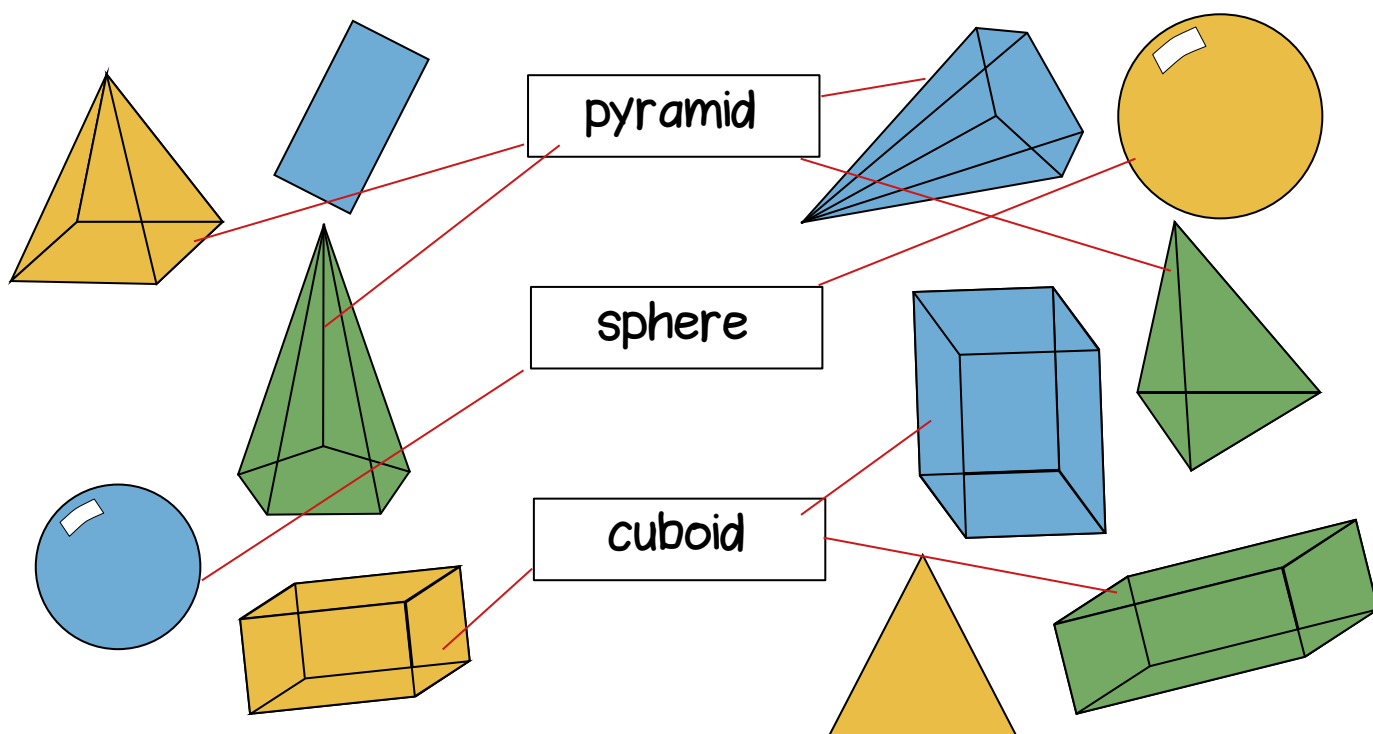
Do It 2

Label pyramids with P
Label spheres with S



Challenge It 2

Match the shape to the name
Not all shapes match to a name!





Same and Different

Play It 2

You need:

A range of 3-D shapes in a bag

To play: (This is a collaborative activity.)

Both players take a shape out of the bag.

Player 1 states something that is the same about the two shapes.

Player 2 states something that is different about the two shapes.

For example:

Player 1: Both of our shapes are cuboids.

Player 2: My cuboid is tall and thin. Yours is short and wide.

Players swap roles.
