Dessert: Tiramisu

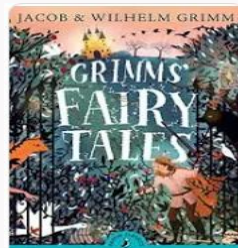
Hobbies/Interests: I love to crochet and I love walking.
