 - ♥ Add in your own **All About Me** on the last page.



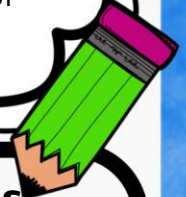
MEET

Dessert: Apple crumble & custard

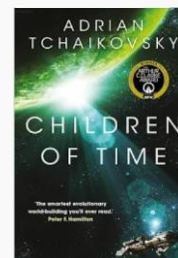
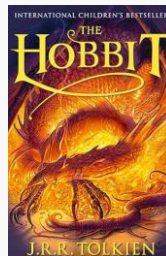
Hobbies/Interests: I love to keep fit and still enjoy playing football. I like spending time with family and as you probably all know – I love to read!

Book: To Kill a Mockingbird by Harper Lee had a huge impact on me when I read it at school

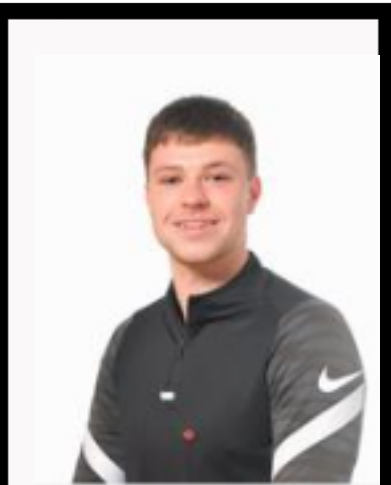
Favourite Topic/Most excited about:

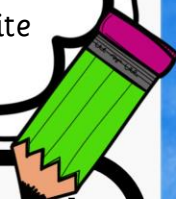
Miss Kwiatkowska

Dessert: vanilla ice-cream with nuts and berries



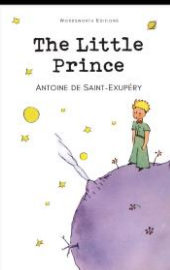
Hobbies/Interests: aikido, long walks with my dog, nature, science
