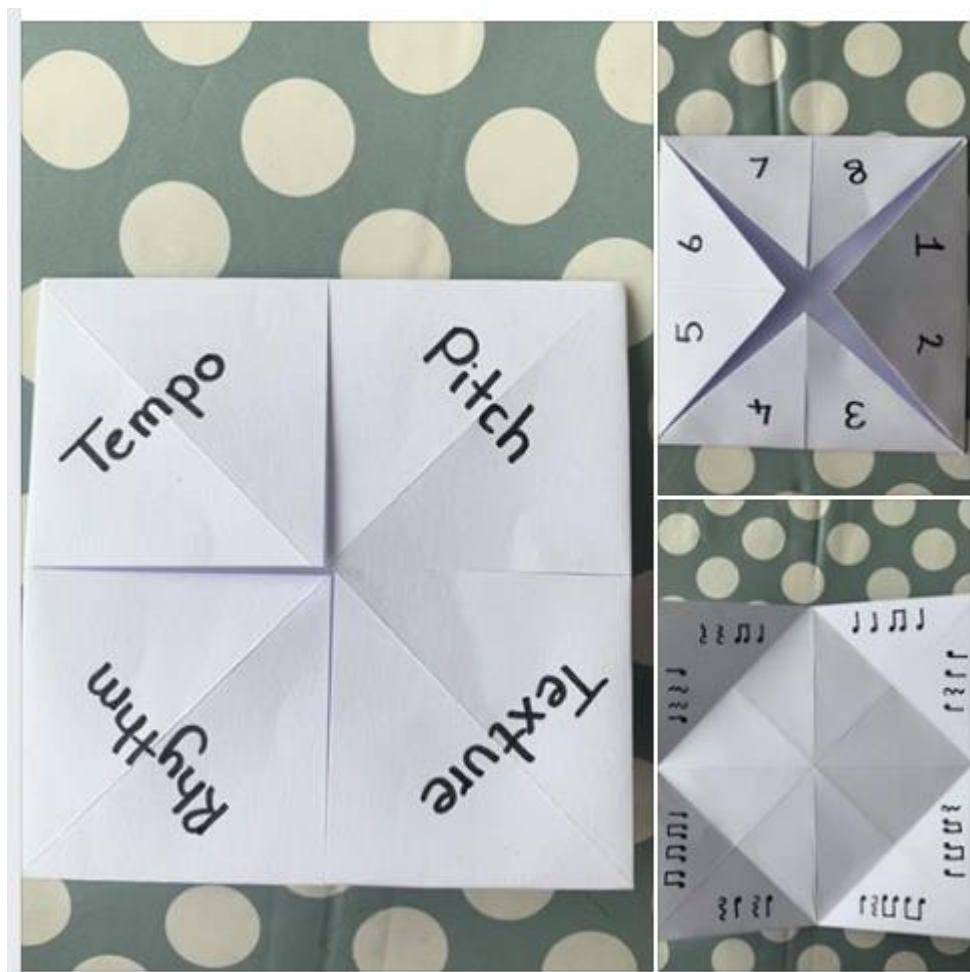

The hen has two feet so can only step on TWO beat notes.

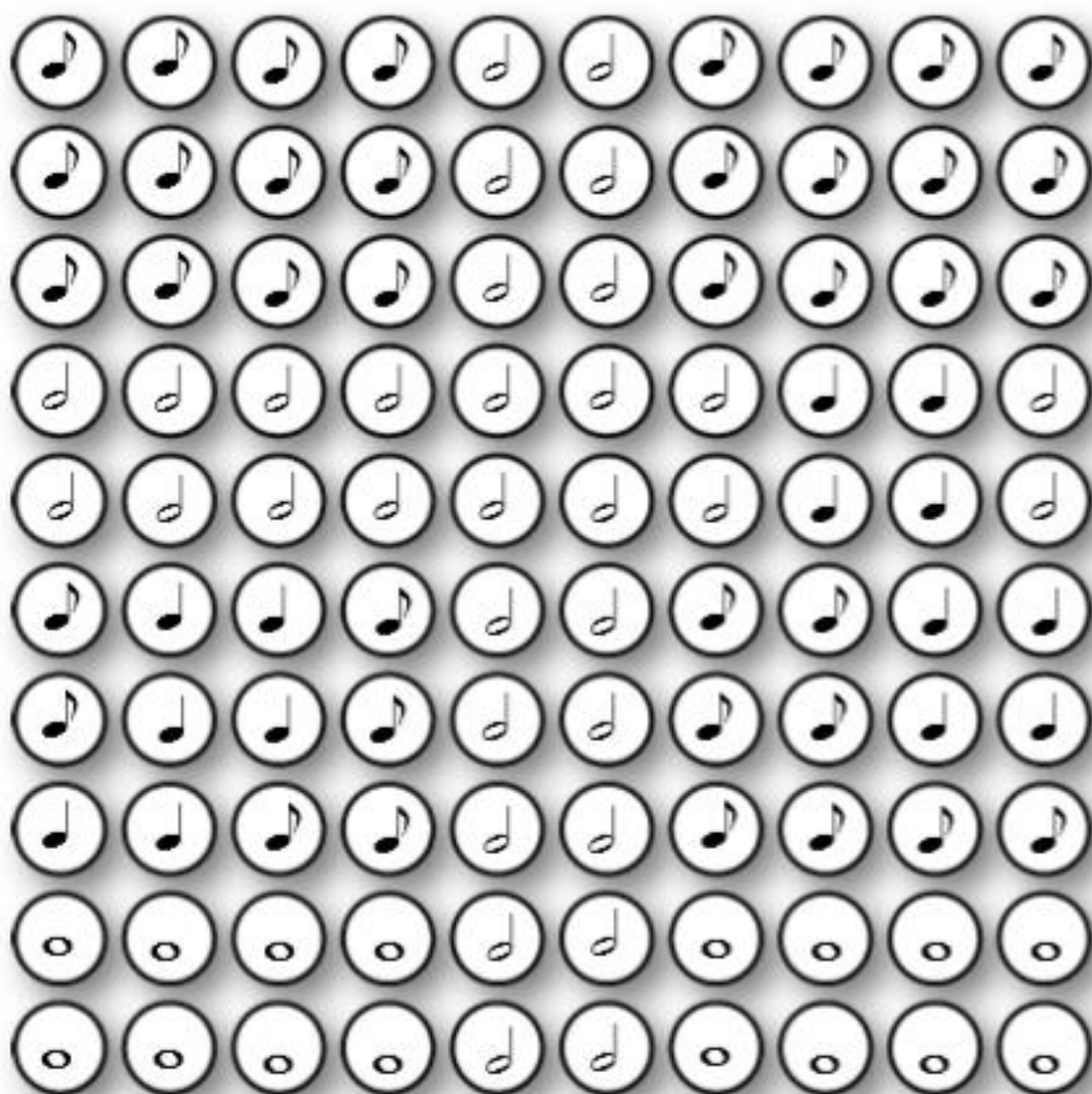
Draw a path that only has two beats.
