Dessert: Banoffee Pie

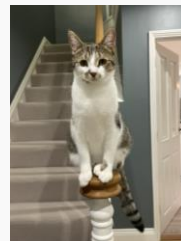
Hobbies/Interests: I love going on walks with my friends and spending time with my family. I live at home with my cat, Lula! ☺

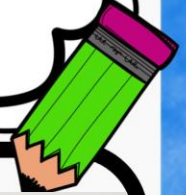
Mrs Russell

Hobbies/Interests:

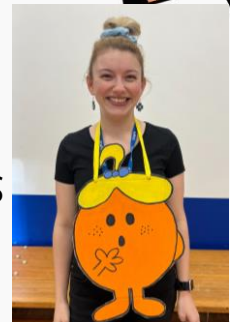
I love spending time on the beach or by the sea and reading books. I have one younger sister. I was born in Australia and lived there until I was 6!

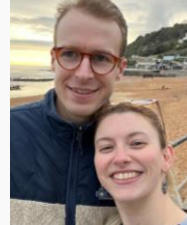

Dessert: Anything with chocolate!

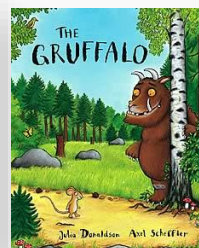
Hobbies/Interests: I
